He then trained as the Renal Medicine/Hemodialysis Fellow at the Animal Medical Center in New York, NY.

Board certified and proficient in all fields of small animal internal medicine (including gastrointestinal, respiratory, immune-mediated, endocrine/hormonal, and infectious diseases), Dr. Eatroff has also undergone intensive training in nephrology/hemodialysis and therapeutic plasma exchange. Included in his experience is having authored many journal articles and textbook chapters and having lectured nationally on topics including kidney disease and hemodialysis.

Dr. Eatroff has been involved in the growth and development of three hemodialysis units in both New York City and Los Angeles and is considered a leader in the field of nephrology/hemodialysis and therapeutic plasma exchange. He is a Clinical Professor of Veterinary Medicine at Western University of Health Sciences.
